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Topic 10 Engagement and Ownership

When we use assessment *for* learning and engage students in all aspects of assessment in support of their learning, they become more invested in the learning. This is because we involve them in connecting what they already know to what they need to know. We help them understand ways they can shape how they show proof of learning. In this online learning opportunity, consider how student learning and achievement are greatly enhanced when assessment is used in the service of learning and what teachers can do to make a greater difference.

Topic 11 Self- and Peer Assessment

When we engage students in mindful, informed self- and peer assessment, the amount of feedback for learning increases exponentially. Students learn to self-monitor and self reflect. When we ask students to attach evidence of learning – proof – to substantiate their self-assessment, we increase the specificity and power of self-assessment. Yet, sometimes it can seem as though self- and peer assessment is just a waste of time. In this session, learn ways to engage learners that actually make a difference, support learning, and save time.

Topic 12 Students Communicating Evidence of their Learning

As part of the learning process, teachers involve students in communicating evidence of their learning to others. They seek feedback for themselves and inform others of the learning that has taken place. This can have many looks: informal communication such as students sharing work samples with parents at home, online, or at school or formal processes such as student-led, student-involved, or student-parent-teacher conferences. During this learning opportunity, you and your colleagues will learn ten easy ways to involve students in communicating ongoing evidence of their learning to others, either in or out of school.
